MARTHA'S VINEYARD Barn Style, Reconceived



A circa 1850 cattle barn was brought from New Hampshire to Martha's Vineyard by boat and reassembled to create a two-bedroom residence, with interiors by Greg Jordan (*AD*, December 2004). Exposed beams and a brick fireplace are in the great room (left), which

contains the living and dining areas and the kitchen. A newly constructed wing houses the bedrooms and a family room with a bay window. A mahogany terrace and an aromatic garden surround the pool area (above). \$5.5 million. Call 508-536-5465.



CANADA Contemporary Aerie Above Whistler

High atop Whistler Mountain in Whistler, British Columbia, is a five-bedroom house with a ski-in, ski-out location. The double-height entrance hall has walls of stone

and a limestone floor (above right) and leads to a great room with a vaulted ceiling and a floor-to-ceiling stone fireplace. A coffered ceiling tops the dining area. The master suite is on the third



floor. A two-tier infinity-edge pool with a spa is surrounded by a heated deck. A 2,000-bottle wine cellar has an adjoining tasting area. \$17.1 million. Call 604-905-6309.
